## How to apply for our service

**There are many ways to apply, ranging from self referral or from a relative or advocate to referral from any health care professional such as your G.P., Consultant, Social worker, local community worker.**

You will then be invited to visit us and an assessment carried out to ensure your needs can be met by our service. Once a decision has been made you will be informed in writing. Your chosen family, friend, advocate or others are encouraged to be involved in this process.
